

Scheme for running of Khel Nursery by Schools-Terms and Conditions

The Department of Sports & Youth Affairs Government of Haryana is implementing the scheme of running Khel Nurseries by the Schools. High Schools and Senior Secondary Schools are covered in the scheme. The following terms and conditions are applicable:-

1. Private and Government High Schools and Senior Secondary Schools are eligible to apply. A school will not be allotted more than two khel nurseries.
2. The School should have the Playground/Court/Hall and other facilities of the game for which sports nursery is applied by it.
3. The School allotted Sports Nursery has to conduct Sports & Physical Aptitude Test/Game test for the students under the supervision of District Sports & Youth Affairs Officer in the age group of 8 to 19 Years.
4. The Khel Nurseries can be opened in sports disciplines played in Olympics Games, Asian Games, Commonwealth Games or National Games and the corresponding Para tournaments.
5. 25 students will be selected based on the test. If the number of student-trainees falls below the minimum number specified game wise by the department, the nursery will be closed.
6. Attendance of the players and coaches will be marked regularly.
7. The School will provide the Sports Kit to the selected trainees/players.
8. Scholarship/diet money will be paid to the students as under:-
 - i) Rs. 1500/-per month per player in age group 8-14 years.
 - ii) Rs. 2000/- per month per player in age group 15-19 years.
9. Honorarium to the coaches will be given as under:-
 - i) Rs. 25000 per month for Coaching Diploma holders from NIS Patiala or any Institute recognized by the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports as equivalent to NIS, Patiala; and
 - ii) Rs. 20000 per month for M.P.Ed or D.P.Ed or M.A. (Physical Education) or NIS Certificate Course in Coaching. In this case, the person must also be a national player in the concerned game.
10. The honorarium to the coach and scholarship/diet money to the student-trainees will be paid by the school into their bank accounts.
11. The Coach will be engaged by the school with prior approval of the concerned District Sports & Youth Affairs officer (DSYAO).
12. Upto Rs. 1.00 lakh per year will be reimbursed to the School for expenses incurred on sports equipment/consumables. The purchase will be supervised by the Deputy Commissioner/or his authorized representative(s).
13. A grant-in-aid of Rs. 2.5 lakhs for each nursery will be released in favour of the concerned school in advance. Further release of grant-in-aid would be on quarterly basis and contingent upon submission of a statement of accounts duly verified and attested by the Head of the School to the concerned DSYAO. The subsequent release of grant-in-aid would be a reimbursement of the amount admissible and validly spent by the School under the Scheme during the previous quarter. The quarterly statement of accounts submitted by the School would show the amount spent under the scheme on:-
 - a) honorarium paid to the coach,
 - b) Scholarship/diet money disbursed to the trainees, with their Names, Father's name and Aadhar No., along with attested copy of the attendance register, and

- c) Expenditure incurred on up gradation/creation of sports infrastructure in the School in the sanctioned game and sports related consumable items, duly supported by vouchers.
14. The students have to attend coaching session in Khel Nursery for at least 22 days in a month to be entitled for scholarship/diet money.
 15. Sportspersons have to keep themselves away from drugs and anti-social activities.
 16. Sportspersons have to maintain strict discipline.
 17. The DSYAO will regularly inspect and monitor the nurseries.
 18. Sports Department reserves the right to withdraw scholarship and/or honorarium in case of any violation.
 19. The scheme is intended to popularize the sports at the grass-root level by utilizing the sports infrastructure/facilities in the institutions. It will be implemented subject to availability of funds. It confirms no right of any kind whatsoever on any institution or player.
