No. 15/1/2019-4SYA.— The Governor of Haryana is pleased to constitute the State Youth Commission for overseeing implementation of the programmes for educating and empowering the youths in the State, as under:-

2. Functions of the Commission :

The Commission shall oversee implementation of the programmes for educating and empowering the youths in the State and to perform such functions as the Government may, from time to time, assign to it.

3. The Chairperson shall be appointed by the State Government, who shall be an eminent person having experience of youth development related activities.

4. The age of the Chairperson shall not be more than 40 years on the date of appointment.

5. The term of the office of the Chairperson shall, in the first instance be one year from the date of assuming charge. The Government may, however, curtail the period of term at any time or extend it from time to time.

6. The Chairperson may, at any time, by writing under his hand addressed to the Government, resign from his office.

7. The Government may, by order, remove the Chairperson from his office if he, -

- (a) is adjudged as an insolvent; or
- (b) has been convicted and sentenced to imprisonment for an offence which, in the opinion of the Government, involves moral turpitude; or
- (c) becomes of unsound mind and stand so declared by a competent Court; or
- (d) without obtaining leave of absence from the Commission, is absent from three consecutive meetings of the Commission; or
- (e) is in the opinion of the Government, abused his official position so as to render his continuance in office prejudicial to the interest of the youth or to the public interest:

Provided that no person shall be removed under this clause unless he has been given a reasonable opportunity of being heard.
